Winery attributes file (“WINERY_PUBLIC.dbf”)

This dBase file forms the core of the Winery Database. It contains the details of each winery’s approval based on its most recent (or pending) use permit approval. Please note that database figures listed for pending wineries are subject to change based on the use permit review and approval process. If you are accessing this file using GIS, you can reference its metadata for details on each field within the database file. Details on the fields are provided below if you are using software other than GIS (e.g. a spreadsheet program like Microsoft Excel):

<i>Winery database fields:</i>	
OBJECTID	Internal feature number. Sequential unique whole numbers that are automatically generated.
ID	Unique Winery Identification Number.
Name	Winery name.
Status	Status of the winery. <i>APVD:</i> Approved winery, not producing <i>PEND:</i> Winery pending approval <i>PROD:</i> Active winery <i>PRODMOD:</i> Active winery, with major use permit modification application pending <i>UNKNWN:</i> Status unknown, needs follow-up
BldSz_Orig	Total approved (or proposed for pending wineries) original size of winery building or buildings, measured in square feet. Covered work areas are included in this figure.
BldSz_Curr	Total approved (or proposed for pending wineries) current size of winery building or buildings, measured in square feet. Covered work areas are included in this figure.
Has_Cave	Indicates whether the winery includes a cave. Wineries (or winery proposals) with caves contain an 'x' in this column.
CaveSize	The total size of the cave, measured in square feet.
Prod_Orig	The originally approved (or proposed for pending wineries) production volume, measured in GPY (gallons per year).
Prod_Curr	The currently approved (or proposed for pending wineries) production volume, measured in GPY (gallons per year). For new and proposed wineries this figure may be the same as Prod_Orig.

Tour_Tastg

The approved (or proposed for pending wineries) tours and tastings arrangement:

APPT: By appointment only
NO: No tours, no tasting
PUB: Open to the public, no appointment necessary
PVT: Private
TST APPT: Tasting by appointment only

Visit_Day

The approved (or proposed for pending wineries) maximum number of daily visitors. NOTE: This is not always an exact number, as some wineries in the past were approved based on an average number of daily visitors.

Visit_Week

The approved (or proposed for pending wineries) maximum number of weekly visitors.

NOTE: This is not always an exact number, as some wineries in the past were approved based on an average number of weekly visitors.

Visit_Yr

The total number of approved (or proposed for pending wineries) visitors per year. Unless otherwise stated in the use permit approval, this figure is generated by taking the *Visit_Week* field and multiplying it by 52 weeks.

Visit_Mktg

The total number of approved (or proposed for pending wineries) visitors per year, based on the winery's marketing plan.

NOTE: in most cases this figure is considered in addition to regular visitation.

Visit_NmEv

The total number of approved (or proposed for pending wineries) marketing events per year, based on the winery's marketing plan.

Visit_ALL

The total number of approved (or proposed for pending wineries) regular winery visitors plus marketing event visitors per year.

EmplpyeeNum

The total number of approved (or proposed for pending wineries) employees at the winery.

This is not always an exact figure. In some cases winery use permit applications ask for a range (10 or fewer, 11-24, etc.), and in some cases an exact number is provided. For ranges, the max value is listed.

For exact figures, FT employees are expressed as provided and PT employees are expressed as 0.5 per employee (i.e. a winery with 4 FT and 3 PT employees would be 5.5 total)

ParkingNum

The total number of approved (or proposed for pending wineries) parking spaces at the winery.

WDO

This field denotes if the winery was established prior to the date of effectiveness (Feb 22, 1990) of the Winery Definition Ordinance. Wineries are considered pre-WDO if this column contains an "x".

NOTE: being designated pre-WDO in this case does not necessarily mean the winery still retains certain pre-WDO conditions. Subsequent use permits may have altered certain aspects of the winery's original approval.

<p>Last_UP The application number of the last known use permit for the winery.</p>
<p>In_CityBdy Denotes whether or not the winery falls within city limits. Wineries with an "x" in this field fall within city limits.</p>
<p>In_AIASP Denotes whether or not the winery falls within the Airport Industrial Area Specific Plan (AIASP). Wineries with an "x" in this field fall within the AIASP.</p>
<p>SmlWnryExm This field denotes if the winery was established through the Small Winery Use Permit Exemption process. Wineries established through the Small Winery Use Permit Exemption process have an "x" in this column. <i>NOTE: subsequent use permit approvals/modifications may have altered certain aspects of the winery's original small winery exemption status.</i></p>
<p>Apprv_date The approval date of the most recent use permit in the MM/DD/YYYY format.</p>
<p>Estab_date The estimated date that the winery was put into operation (usually the first crush), expressed in the MM/DD/YYYY format.</p>
<p>Total_Size The total size of the winery (or proposed winery), expressed in square feet. This is the total building size plus the total cave size, if applicable.</p>
<p>Subj_to_75 This field denotes whether or not the winery is subject to the 75% grape sourcing rule (see Winery Definition Ordinance for details). Winery entries with an "x" in this column are subject to the 75% rule.</p>
<p>GPY_at_75 This field lists the amount of wine, expressed in GPY (gallons per year) that is subject to the 75% rule. Of the GPY listed in this field, 75% of it must be sourced from within Napa County. <i>NOTE: for newer wineries, this number may match the figure in the "Prod_Curr" field. For older wineries, especially pre-WDO wineries who have expanded their production area, the two figures could be different.</i></p>
<p>AVA Lists the name of the AVA (American Viticultural Area) that the winery falls within.</p>
<p>SUP_dist Lists the corresponding Napa County Board of Supervisor District number that the winery falls within.</p>

Wineries falling within city boundaries

GIS staff uses a combination of data from the US Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau (TTB), California Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC), and coordination with local agencies to map locations of wineries within city boundaries. These locations are considered approximate at best. Details (e.g. production, visitation, etc.) regarding wineries that fall within city jurisdiction are not included in the winery database. Please consult individual cities for information on these wineries.
